STUDENT PAYMENT OPTIONS/ STUDENT BALANCES

Spartanburg District One Schools have numerous prepayment options that are available for our families. The purpose of having a meal account is to increase speed of service and is not intended to be a charge account. Payments by the week or month are the preferred methods. We accept cash and checks at each school and most major credit and debit cards at www.mypaymentsplus.com.

Online meal payment is available by visiting our software provider at www.mypaymentsplus.com. Payments totaling over \$50.00 will have NO fee applied to the transaction. Payments under \$50.00 will have a fee based upon a percentage of the transaction. Please visit www.mypaymentsplus.com for more information. PLEASE NOTE THAT UNPAID STUDENT BALANCES CARRY OVER TO THE NEXT SCHOOL YEAR.

FREE AND REDUCED

Free and reduced lunch benefits are available to those families that complete an application and meet the guidelines of eligibility set by the USDA. Please be aware that **each school year**, you are responsible for completing a new and up to date **SCDE Application for Free and Reduced Price School Meals**.

If you receive lunch benefits, please note that you are responsible for any lunch balances that may accrue prior to your application approval date. These balances will carry over from previous years and will follow your student until graduation. The free and reduced benefit only pertains to a regular school lunch. **Your child will be charged extra for a la carte items.**

- Once your application is processed (approved or denied), you will be notified in writing of your approval status and effective date. Your benefits start on approval date and not before.
- **If you do not receive a letter confirming receipt /approval/denial of your application please, contact Lauren Brown at 864-472-2846**
- If you have a credit balance and have a student withdrawing or graduating, we can issue a refund on any remaining money that is left on your child's account or transfer balances to a sibling's account. Please notify the cafeteria manager if this should apply.
